

Charity Officer– Myrovlytis Trust

The [Myrovlytis Trust](#) is a medical charity promoting research into rare genetic kidney disorders such as Birt-Hogg-Dubé syndrome. Since 2007, we have awarded more than £4.5 million in research grants to laboratories around the world.

The Myrovlytis Trust currently has a full-time position available for a Charity Officer.

The successful candidate will have a key role in enabling the growth of the Trust. You will gain experience working in the medical research sector, as well as contributing your ideas at the core of an international research-funding organisation. For the right person, there may be opportunity for the position to develop.

Specific duties include:

- Maintaining awareness of advances in research into BHD syndrome to help contribute to the Trust's scientific strategy;
- Some communication with the BHD research community, including website maintenance and content generation;
- Liaising with grant holders to optimise research progress;
- Assisting with other appropriate Myrovlytis Trust matters as required.

Desired competencies:

You will have a degree in a relevant biological science, ideally a PhD. You will be capable of working independently and using your own initiative. You will have excellent interpersonal and communication (written and oral) skills, and a strong commitment to open communication, flexibility and participation at all levels. You will have good IT skills, a willingness to learn, and be able to work to tight deadlines. You will be understanding and sensitive when dealing with people affected by, and professionals concerned with, rare genetic diseases. Candidates with familiarity with publication-level scientific style might be preferred.

The position will be based at the Trust's offices in SW1, London. Salary will be competitive and commensurate with experience.
